EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE GENERAL MANAGER,
PHILIPPINE PORTS AUTHORITY (PPA) TO ALLOCATE THE
NECESSARY FUNDS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT/CONSTRUCTION
OF A RORO PORT AT BARANGAY BALATASAN, MUNICIPALITY
OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

"WHEREAS, the litany of the financial powerlessness of the Local Government Unit to appropriate the necessary funds for the basic services to channel the goods for good governance towards the benefits of the locality;

"WHEREAS, under Section 25 of Republic Act 7160 dealing with Intergovernmental relation particularly between the national government and the local government unit thru the President may upon request of the LGU concerned direct the appropriate national agency to provide financial, technical or any form of assistance to the LGU and such assistance shall be extended at no extra cost to the LGU concerned;

"WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro being the coastal town and a gateway to several provinces such as Occidental Mindoro, Palawan, Panay Island and the considered the most famous Island of Boracay which is only almost two (2) hours of travel from the requested port;

"WHEREAS, the ample powers granted to the Municipality over tourism in its area of jurisdiction needs the most interplay as some other tourists may seek other tourist destination wherein Bulalacao is a big possibility that it has eleven (11) tourists spot reserves boasting almost virginal tropical come-otts;

"WHEREAS, the benefits that could be gained from the construction and the subsequent operation of a roro port in the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro shall redound to the socio-economic benefits of our nation in the following senses:



- ii. Cordlary to this, tourism shall have a big boost as transportation means is always the usual reason for the discouragement for them to come to our exctic places;
- iii. It would be a great relief for the "hoipolloi" whose travels to and fro from the provinces and the cities are bound to make them suffer longer transportation cost;
- iv. The exchange of culture, arts diversified by the archipelagic situation is bound to be linked by such a mode of a modern and effective transportation means;
