EARNESTLY REQUESTING HONORABLE DOMINGO F. PANGANIBAN, SECRETARY, DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE TO PLEASE ISSUE AN ORDER DELIENATING THE BOUNDARY OF THE MUNICIPAL WATERS BETWEEN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO AND THE MUNICIPALITY OF CALUYA, PROVINCE OF ANTIQUE

"WHEREAS, now that the issue of territorial jurisdiction over the dominion on Lwagao Island being reclaimed by the Province of Oriental Mindoro and yet until now has not come through a settlement between the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of two provinces, this Municipality is not relenting to reclaim its lost territory,

"WHEREAS, assessing all the documents upon proper perusal the issue of Lwagao was resolved by the revocation of Administrative Order No. 17 dated March 17, 2003 is tantamount to the fact that the territorial dominion over the subject island as we have ever since insisted it is ours;


"WHEREAS, contemplating about the written facts and evidences and the narration of the elders as well as the wishful expectations of the young generation of today still continue the bond to its mother Bulalacao through trade, commerce and industry and the facilitation of education and health services acknowledging that indeed Bulalacao is their mother town; Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: Earnestly request Hon. Domingo F. Panganiban, Secretary, Department of Agriculture to please Issue an order delineating the boundary of the municipal waters between the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro and the Municipality of Caluya, Province of Antique;


