RESOLUTION NO. 05-10-134

EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE EMBASSY OF JAPAN TO GRANT EXCAVATING EQUIPMENTS SUCH AS CRANES PROCESSING EQUIPMENTS, SURVEY EQUIPMENTS, LIGHT RADAR DEVICES, X-RAY ANALYZER EQUIPMENT OF CULTURAL ASSETS, ETC., CONSIDERING THAT THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO WAS IN INTERDEPENDENCE WITH JAPANESE AND CHINESE CIVILIZATION SINCE 17TH CENTURY

"WHEREAS, the government of Japan under the Japanese Cultural Grant Aid introduced a novel skin into 2005 combining the former cultural grant aid CGA (Grant Aid for Cultural heritage) whereby up to 300 million yen per project can be granted to cover the procurement cost of equipment to be used for various cultural and educational activities, including the cost of equipment, transportation and installation as well as construction and renovation of facilities;

"WHEREAS, it is heart-warming to note that since the launching of the CGA in FY 1975, Japan benevolently granted a total of 51.8 billion yen for 1257 projects in 136 countries under that skinned; luckily the Philippines alone got 44 projects amounting to about 1.8 trillion yen;

"WHEREAS, knowing that Japan Cultural Grant Aid (JCGA) donates funds directly to the governments of the recipient countries and giving priority in pleasing responsibility for the management and maintenance within a government related organization;


"WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao, Province of Mindoro, Republic of the Philippines has been informed with this kind of opportunity should like to be benefited from the same noble objectives of JCGA by requesting the Japanese Government for cranes processing equipments, survey equipments, light radar devices, x-ray analyzer equipment of cultural assets, etc.;

"WHEREAS, Bulalacao lies within the southernmost tip of the Island of Mindoro and is classified to be a Pro-Poor Municipality and those requested materials in the implementation of a joint project which hopefully be sponsored by JOGA shall redound to the economic, social and most especially cultural benefits in the interplay and exchange of culture and traditions between the two (2) social communities; Now, therefore, be it






