RESOLUTION NO. 05-10-133

EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE JICC FOR JUDO, BOXING, GYMNASTIC OR ANY AVAILABLE ATHLETIC EQUIPMENTS IN PURSUIT OF THE DEVELOPMENT OF SPORTS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

"WHEREAS, the government of Japan under the Japanese Cultural Grant Aid introduced a novel skin into 2005 combining the former cultural grant aid OGA (Grant Aid for Cultural heritage) whereby up to 300 million years per project can be granted to cover the procurement cost of equipment to be used for various cultural and educational activities, including the cost of equipment, transportation and installation as well as construction and renovation of facilities;

"WHEREAS, it is heart-warming to note that since the launch of the OGA in FY 1975, Japan benevolently granted a total of 51.8 billion yen for 1257 projects in 136 countries under that skinned; luckily the Philippines alone got 44 projects amounting to about 1.8 trillion yen;

"WHEREAS, knowing that Japan Cultural Grant Aid (JCGA) donates funds directly to the governments of the recipient countries and giving priority in pleasing responsibility for the management and maintenance within a government related organization.


"WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao, Province of Mindoro, Republic of the Philippines having been informed with this kind of opportunity should like to be benefited from the same noble objectives of JCGA by requesting the Japanese Government for Judo, Boxing, Gymnastic, or any available athletic equipments in pursuit of the development of sports;


