ORDINANCE NO. 14

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE APPLICANTS APPLYING FOR MARRIAGE LICENSE TO PRESENT A CERTIFICATION FROM FAMILY PLANNING AND COUNSELLING SERVICE THAT THEY HAVE BEEN INFORMED ABOUT THE FAMILY PLANNING BEFORE MARRIAGE LICENSE BE ISSUED AND TO PAY THE FOLLOWING CORRESPONDING RATES OF FEES AS REQUIRED

Be, it ordained by the Sanguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, That.

SEC. 1. For the purpose of implemation, Presidential Decree No. 79, revising the population Act of 1971, of the family planning program, it is strictly prohibited to any local civil registrar and/or his duly authorized representative to issue marriage license not having been presented a certification from family planning and counseling service;

Sec. 2.-It is also likewise, before marriage license be issued to any applicant applying for marriage license, a certification from family planning and counseling service be fully secured and to present it to local civil Registrar of this Municipality and to pay the following corresponding rates of fees as pre-requisites for issuance of marriage license to any applicant to wit.


- (a) For the issuance of certification of family planning and counseling service to applicant by the Municipal Health Officer and /or his authorized representative, - - - - - ₱ 5.00
- (b) For the issuance of the Municipal Health Officer and /or his authorized representative, for needed employment - - - - - ₱ 2.00

SEC 3, Penalty: Any violation of section 1 and 2 respectively of this Ordinance, shall upon conviction for its offense, be punished by a fine of not less than five (₱ 5,00 pesos, and not more than ten (₱ 10.00) pesos, and imprisonment of not less than five days and not more than ten days or both such fine imprisonment in the discretion of the court;

SEC. 4 Any Ordinance or Ordinances inconsistent with any section of this Ordinance shall be null and void;

SEC. 5. Effectively. This Ordinance shall take effect after ten (10) days of its approval.
