EARNESTLY REQUESTING CONGRESSMAN ALFONSO V. UMALI, JR., TO ALLOCATE FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF FOOTBRIDGE CONNECTING BARANGAY BALATASAN TO TAMBARON ISLAND AND FROM TAMBARON ISLAND TO BARANGAY MAASIN, ALL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

“WHEREAS, tourism development mainly refers to the situation of getting quality growth in tourism sectors in terms of its development, strong plans and policies and marketing throughout the world so they all know that places. Moreover, the tourism development includes accessible way to reach the destination, proper facilities like hotels, means of transportation, amenities and others so the tourism can have full satisfaction;

“WHEREAS, Maasin Island is situated at the southeastern part of the Municipality of Bulalacao which is seven (7) kilometers away from the town proper. The only mode of transportation to reach the place is through motor boats. Maasin is declared as tourism zone and marine reserved island with the presence of Marine Protected Area (MPA) rich with marine resources which made it the major supplies of large varieties of fishes and seashells;

“WHEREAS, another major problem of Maasin Island and its nearby island barangay such as Tambaron Island and Balatasan is during the onslaught of bad weather condition where the movement of people and shipment of goods are hampered more particularly when emergencies occur where matters between life and death is concerned;
