**EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE BUREAU OF FISHERIES AND AQUATIC RESOURCES (BFAR)-MIMAROPA THRU ITS REGIONAL DIRECTOR, DR. ELIZER S. SALILIG TO GRANT AT LEAST TWO MILLION PESOS (PhP2M) FROM ITS QUICK RESPONSE FUND TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO TO REHABILITATE DAMAGES TO AQUACULTURE AND FISHING INDUSTRY BROUGHT BY TYPHOON TISOY**

**“WHEREAS**, the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro suffered various losses in agriculture, livestock, aquaculture and fishing industries caused by Typhoon Tisoy which occurred on December 3, 2019 that brought distress, deep grief and misfortune among its inhabitants particularly the marginalized groups;

**“WHEREAS**, Typhoon Tisoy caused minor landslides in certain areas that made delay on several transportation facilities, such as roads and bridges, houses and other building structures were heavily damaged resulted to social and economic turmoil among the residents particularly the poor and the helpless families who were badly affected by this natural calamity;


