**REQUESTING THE PHILIPPINE COAST GUARD TO DETAIL TRAINED CANINE DOGS TO ITS HEADQUARTERS IN BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO TO CONDUCT INSPECTION AND MONITORING ACTIVITIES IN THE BULALACAO PORT, BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO**

**“WHEREAS**, canine dogs work to detect explosives at the airport and seaport and play a key role in keeping air and water transportation safe for travel and commerce. Their speed and flexibility in discovering the presence of explosives and their ability to follow suspicious odors give them a real edge over currently available mechanical detection devices in many circumstances;

**“WHEREAS**, when it comes to public safety and securing certain environments, the significant contribution of professionally trained and handled guard dogs no longer needs to be proven. Canine dogs support security professionals when it comes to surveillance and crowd control. The mere presence of the detection dogs can discourage threatening behavior such as criminal and terrorist acts;


**“WHEREAS**, the Bulalacao Roro Port is an entry point of Fast Cat coming from Caticlan port carrying passengers of different origin and nationality. Likewise, cargoes of various kinds and sizes including commercial and agricultural products keep on unloading everyday that there is a dire need to detail a canine dog to conduct inspection and monitoring to ensure safety of both the travellers and commerce; **Now, therefore, be it**






