ORDINANCE NO. 5

REQUIRING ALL FISH DEALERS TO PAY TO THE MUNICIPAL TREASURER OR HIS AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE, THE CORRESPONDING FEES OF FRESH AND DRIED FISH AND CANS OF SALTED FISH, BEFORE TRANSPORTING SAME FROM THIS MUNICIPALITY TO OTHER MUNICIPALITIES OR TO BATANGAS AND MANILA FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES

WHEREAS, hundreds of kilos of fresh and dried fish and cans/bags of salted fish were transported by fish Dealers from this municipality to other municipalities or to Batangas and Manila for commercial purposes;

WHEREAS, in order to raise the revenue of this municipality and to regulate fees in fresh and dried fish and cans/bags of salted fish being transported to other municipalities, the Sangguniang Bayan hereby ordians, that;

SECTION 1. All fish dealers of fresh and dried fish and cans/bags of salted fish are hereby required to pay to the Municipal Treasurer or his authorized representative the corresponding fees enumerated hereunder, before transporting same from this municipality to other municipalities for commercial purposes;

- a) Assorted fresh fish P 0.10 per kilo
- b) Assorted P 0.10 " "
- c) Salted fish P 3.00 " "

SECTION 2. No fish commodities shall be transported unless its corresponding fees in form of cash tickets itemized in Section hereof, be fully paid;

SECTION 3. Violation of this Ordinance or parts hereof. shall be punished by a fine of P 100.00 to P 500.00 and an imprisonment of 15 to 30 days or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court;


SECTION 4. Ordinance or Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly;

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately;

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished, the Sangguniang Pabalawigan, Calapan, Oriental Mindoro for review and approval;
