ORDINANCE NO. 15-10-153

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE SUBMISSION OF PHILHEALTH PREMIUM REMITTANCE CERTIFICATION AS A REQUISITE IN SECURING BUSINESS PERMITS AMONG PRIVATE ESTABLISHMENTS

“WHEREAS, Section 11, Article XII of the 1987 Philippine Constitution declares that the State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development which shall endeavor to make essential goods, health and other services available to all people at affordable cost, priority for the needs of the underprivileged, sick, elderly, disabled, women and children shall be recognized. Likewise, it shall be the policy of the State to provide free medical care to paupers;

“WHEREAS, pursuant to this Constitutional mandate, R.A. No. 7875, otherwise known as the National Health Insurance Act of 1995 was enacted by Congress to provide for the creation of National Health Insurance Program which shall provide health insurance coverage and ensure affordable, acceptable and accessible health care services for all citizens of the Philippines;

"WHEREAS, Local Government Units are enjoined to support and ensure compliance with Section 6 of R.A. No. 7875 which mandates coverage of all citizens of the Philippines in the National Health Insurance Program;

"WHEREAS, pursuant to the Administrative Order No. 277, dated June 25, 1996 issued by the Office of the President, the National Government and the Local Government Units are directed to ensure speedy implementation of the National Health Insurance Program (NHIP);

"WHEREAS, Section 4 of the Revised Rules and Regulations implementing the National Health Insurance Act of 1995, provides for the mandatory coverage of the employed in the government and private sectors. The enrollment of the indigent households and individual paying group which comprise the majority of the Filipinos not covered by the health insurance shall be insured.

"WHEREAS, R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, grants Local Government Units (LGUs) genuine autonomy to enable them to attain their fullest development as self-reliant communities and make them more effective partners to the attainment of the national goals;

"WHEREAS, the same statute states that Local Government Units shall exercise powers and discharge the duties and functions currently vested upon them. They shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate or incidental to efficient and effective provision of the basic services and facilities;

"WHEREAS, it is a dire need to address the increasing demand for affordable health care benefits for the residents of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro and ensure that they receive the benefits from the services they performed for the employers;

"WHEREAS, in order to realize the vision to provide all citizens with the mechanism to gain financial access to health benefits, Local Government Units shall find ways to ensure that prescribed policies are in place;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, as it is hereby ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro in Session assembled that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as **"An Ordinance Requiring the Submission of PhilHealth Premium Remittance Certification as Requisite in Securing Business Permits among Private Establishments in the Municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro."**

SEC. 2. PhilHealth Premium Remittance Certificate as a Pre-requisite to issuance of Business Permits. All business establishments doing business within the territorial jurisdiction of this Municipality and which are required to secure business permits from the local government shall not be issued such business permit except upon submission of a certification of premium remittance from the PhilHealth Office;




SEC. 3. Municipal Permits and Licensing Office. The Municipal Permits and Licensing Office or its equivalent office in-charge is hereby mandated to ensure that this Ordinance is faithfully and strictly enforced.

SEC. 4. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.




