MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 19-03-226

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING TWO (2) ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT III POSITIONS WITH PLANTILLA ITEM NUMBERS 8 & 9 AND REAPPROPRIATING THE CORRESPONDING FUNDS FROM THE OFFICE OF THE MUNICIPAL MAYOR TO THE MUNICIPAL HEALTH OFFICE OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO THEREBY OPERATIONALIZING SECTION 3.D. OF APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 19-03-01 OR SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 1 OF FISCAL YEAR 2019

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro:

Section 1. Statement of Policy. It is the policy of the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao to uphold and observe Section 76 of the Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as Local Government Code of 1991 which provides that every local government unit shall design and implement its own organizational structure and staffing pattern taking into consideration its service requirements and financial capabilities, subject to the minimum standards and guidelines prescribed by the Civil Service Commission.

Section 2. Transfer of Positions. Two (2) Administrative Assistant III positions with plantilla item numbers 8 & 9 are hereby transferred from the Office of the Municipal Mayor to the Municipal Health Office. Incumbents of those positions shall report to the latter immediately after the effectivity of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Funding Requirement. The corresponding fund in the Office of the Municipal Mayor which was appropriated for such positions through Municipal Appropriation Ordinance No. 18-12-28 are hereby re-appropriated to the Municipal Health Office. Additional fund needed for the implementation of this ordinance has been already appropriated through Section 3.D. of Appropriation Ordinance No. 19-03-01 or Supplemental Budget No. 1 for fiscal year 2019, to wit:

"D. Municipal Health Office

- i. Personal Services
 - a. Salaries - PhP 74,300.00
 - b. Retirement and life insurance - PhP 8,916.00
 - c. PhilHealth contribution - PhP 1,021.63
 - d. Pag-Ibig contribution - PhP 1,486.00
 - e. Hazard pay - PhP 92,875.00
 - f. Subsistence allowance - PhP 22,000.00
 - g. Laundry allowance - PhP 3,000.00
 - h. Year-end bonus - PhP 7,430.00
 - i. Mid-year bonus - PhP 7,430.00"

The total fund needed as a result of the transfer shall be included in the appropriations for 2020 and years thereafter. The Municipal Budget Officer shall ensure that the budget necessary for the implementation of this Ordinance shall be properly and adequately appropriated and utilized. The fund appropriated and allocated for this purpose shall not be allowed for realignment and not be certified as savings unless for legitimate reasons.

Section 4. The Human Resource Management Officer shall make the necessary adjustments in the plantilla of positions and shall ensure that all related policies are followed and observed accordingly.

Section 5. Any officer or employee who shall disregard or neglect the implementation of this Ordinance shall be administratively dealt with and such shall be a ground for suspension or dismissal subject to the pertinent provisions of the Civil Service Laws and Rules.

Section 6. Any ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 7. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid, the remainder or any provision hereof not affected thereby shall remain in force and effect. Higher laws or policies inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after fifteen (15) days of posting in bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao.






