**ORDINANCE NO. 17-02-176**

**AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING ORDINANCE NO. 16-09-168 ENTITLED ORDINANCE ADOPTING "ALWAYS WALK RIGHT POLICY" IN BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro:

**SECTION 1. STATEMENT OF POLICY.** It is the policy of the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro (LGU of Bulalacao) to maintain orderliness in all public facilities in order to promote peace and order, public safety, and tourism development.

**SEC. 2. TITLE.** This Ordinance shall be known as Always Walk Right Ordinance of 2016 of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro.

**SEC. 3. PRESCRIBED ACTIVITY.** All users, residents or non-residents of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro, of walkways, pathways, alleys, stairs, footbridges, and sidewalks, shall always walk right in such public facilities.

**SEC. 4. EXCEPTIONS.** Certain concerns shall not be covered by this Ordinance such as:

*(Handwritten signatures)*

- a. Emergency situations whenever safety, health, life, and property are at stake;
- b. Authorized disaster and calamity drills;
- c. Authorized civic and religious activities; and
- d. Other concerns that may be cited in the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) which shall be prepared by the Office of the Municipal Mayor thru the Municipal Administrator within ninety (90) days after the approval of this Ordinance

**SEC. 5. PENALTY.** Any person who shall violate this Ordinance shall be penalized with the following manner:

- a. First offense - fine of PhP 250.00 or community service of 1 day
- b. Second offense - fine of PhP 500.00 or community service of 2 day
- c. Third offense - fine of PhP 750.00 or community service of 3 days


**SEC. 6. ENFORCEMENT.** This Ordinance shall be implemented thru citizen's arrest, as such, any bona fide resident of this municipality may bring any violator to barangay or municipal authorities who will coordinate for the enforcement of appropriate penalty upon finding out that a violation was indeed committed. All payments of fine shall be issued with official receipt by the Municipal Treasury Office.

Penalty shall be imposed only after five (5) years of continuous, educational, and wide support campaign for the effective implementation of this Ordinance, starting on the date of approval. Violators within such period shall be required to conduct an information dissemination activity as identified by any barangay or municipal authority.

**SEC. 7. INFORMATION DISSEMINATION.** All government officials and employees thru the heads of offices, agencies, institutions or organizations shall extend necessary efforts in disseminating to the public this Ordinance and the IRR. In addition, summary of the approved ordinance preferably on 4 feet x 6 feet tarpaulin sponsored by the LGU of Bulalacao thru the efforts of the Secretary to the Sangguniang Bayan shall be posted in all barangay halls and in other conspicuous places of the municipality while written copies shall be posted on bulletin boards of Sangguniang Barangays, Local Government Unit of Bulalacao, other government institutions within the municipality, and non-government institutions.

**SEC. 8. REPEALING CLAUSE.** Any Ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SEC. 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid, the remainder or any provision hereof not affected thereby shall remain in force and effect.



**SEC. 10. EFFECTIVITY.** Unless otherwise stated in this Ordinance, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately after the approval of the Municipal Mayor.




