EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE HONORABLE MANUEL G. ANDAYA, CONGRESSMAN, 2ND DISTRICT, ORIENTAL MINDORO TO ALLOCATE FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF TWO UNITS 2-ROOM SCHOOL BUILDING FOR SITIO TABOK ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND SAN JUAN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL BOTH IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO
