EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE HONORABLE FREDDIE WEBB, CHAIRMAN,
SENATE COMMITTEE ON HEALTH, SENATE OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE
PHILIPPINES, MANILA TO ALLOCATE MEDICINES AND MEDICAL
EQUIPMENTS FOR THE INDIGENT RESIDENTS OF THE MUNICIPALITY
OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

"WHEREAS, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro was declared
as Pro-poor Municipality pursuant to Proclamation No. 390;

"WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao is the south-
ernmost town of the Province of Oriental Mindoro, of moun-
tainous terrains and with a population of approximately
Twenty Four Thousand (24,000) inhabitants does not have
access to proper medical treatment and affordable medicines;

"WHEREAS, the Municipal Health Unit of this municipality
which is manned by a single physician, one nurse and three
midwives could not fully deliver effective and efficient
medical services needed by the residents due primarily to
insufficiency of medicines and inavailability of medical
equipments;


"WHEREAS, due to financial constraints, this Fifth-
Class Municipality could not readily allocate additional
amount to augment the appropriation for the much needed
medicines and medical equipments necessary in the mainte-
nance of good health, prevention and control of diseases
and saving lives particularly during the occurrence of
emergencies;

"WHEREAS, considering that the progress and stabili-
ty of one's country is best described by the good sound of
health of its people, basic health services should be given
top priority; Now, threrfore, be it


