" RESOLUTION NO. 00-11-167

RESOLUTION OF ENDORSEMENT AND SUPPORT TO SENATE BILL NO. 272 FILED BY SENATOR SERGIO OSMEÑA, III ENTITLED " AN ACT INCREASING THE INTERNAL REVENUE ALLOTMENT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS, PROVIDING FOR ITS EQUITABLE DISTRIBUTION, AUTHORIZING ITS AUTOMATIC RETENTION, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTIONS 284, 285 AND 286 OF REPUBLIC ACT 7160"

"WHEREAS, the enactment of Republic Act Numbered 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 called for the devolution of powers and resources from the central government to the local government units to make it more responsive and accountable local government structure;

"WHEREAS, under the Local Government Code, the share of the Local Government Units in the national internal revenue was increased to forty percent (40%) which is a big jump from a measly 11% it previously enjoyed;

"WHEREAS, past experiences of the local executives showed that the internal revenue allotment is not sufficient to meet the financial needs of their constituents as manifested by the widespread requests for funds from higher ranking government officials and national agencies for the construction of various infrastructural facilities such as roads, bridges, school buildings, water systems, etc.;

"WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 272, which is a consolidation of Senate Bill Nos. 2415 and 1629 jointly filed by Senators Sergio Osmeña, III and Neptali Gonzales during the Tenth

Congress proposes to increase the internal revenue allotments of LGUs from the current 40 to 60% at an increase of 5% per annum starting from Fiscal Year 1999. It further seeks to empower the local executives together with the local legislators who are in a better positions to determine the exigencies of their constituencies;


"WHEREAS, the approval of Senate Bill No. 272 will also provide for a more equitable sharing of the cost of devolution among provinces, cities, municipalities and barangays;


"WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 272 will also provide for an automatic retention of IGUs shares instead of turning it over to the national government only, to be remitted it back to the LGU concerned. This cuts the bureaucratic maze that project financing has to handle and it precludes nay president from delaying the release of a local government's share out of sheer partisanship; Now, therefore, be it


