" RESOLUTION NO. 00-06-101

EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE HONORABLE ALFREDO S. LIM, SECRETARY, DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT TO INTERVENE FOR THE IMMEDIATE RESOLUTION OF THE BOUNDARY DISPUTE BETWEEN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO AND MUNICIPALITY OF CALUYA, PROVINCE OF ANTIQUE OVER THE ISLAND OF LIWAGAO

"WHEREAS, it is maintained by the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro that the territorial domain over the Island of Liwagao belongs to the Municipality of Bulalacao by virtue of historic right on legal title; as previous elections were held and geographical maps show that this island really belongs to Bulalacao;

"WHEREAS, in the past, residents of this island registered their ownership by way of filing their Tax Declaration in the Office of the Municipal Assessor of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro hence, proving more that people living therein owed allegiance to the Municipality of Bulalacao as records of their land ownership could be traced to this town;

"WHEREAS, the occupation made by Antique is not and will never be considered valid in the point of view of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro for there was no official agreement neither was there an act of Congress nor an Executive fiat ceding this island to the Province of Antique;

"WHEREAS, it is evident and the records will show that Bulalacao lost territorial jurisdiction only by virtue of mutual agreement between the two former mayors of these two municipalities in 1979;

"WHEREAS, by reason of geographical proximity of the Island of Liwagao to the mainland of Mindoro, the residents therein are regularly conducting their trade and commerce activities with the local entrepreneur of Bulalacao,


"WHEREAS, with the belief that the Municipal Government of Bulalacao could adequately deliver unto them the basic services, the residents of Liwagao made a gesture to return their allegiance to Bulalacao through a Petition; Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: Earnestly request the Honorable Alfredo S. Lim, Secretary, Department of Interior and Local Government to intervene for the immediate resolution of the boundary dispute between the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro and Municipality of Caluya, Province of Antique over the island of Liwagao;




