“WHEREAS, the present administration is focus to expand access and ensuring more Filipinos receive a decent basic education, and to enhance the current educational system, as a means of reducing poverty and improving national competitiveness;

“WHEREAS, pursuant to Executive Order No. 370 the Municipality of Bulalacao is considered as a 3rd class municipality hounded with financial constraints, it is located at the southernmost tip of the Province of Oriental Mindoro and according to the 2020 census it has a population of 44,366 people where almost 25 percent of it are indigenous people called Hanunuo-Mangyans;
