### **RESOLUTION NO. 21-06-181**

**EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS (DPWH) THRU SECRETARY MARK VILLAR TO ALLOCATE THE NECESSARY AMOUNT TO BE USED FOR THE OPENING AND CONCRETING OF SEVERAL LOCAL TOURISM ACCESS ROADS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO**

**“WHEREAS**, the Municipality of Bulalacao is a Pro-Poor Municipality pursuant to Executive Order No. 370 being it, Bulalacao is now emerging into a tourism hub of the Province of Oriental Mindoro because of its rich cultural heritage, beautiful islands and islets with long and powdery white sand beaches, rich marine life resources where everyone could enjoy eating fresh varieties of marine products and wide range of forest resources best for trekking and where everyone could have a chance to have a personal encounter with our hanunuo mangyan brothers and sisters living in the hinterland;

**“WHEREAS**, tourism has become an important factor that has an impact on development because it generates income and employment however, the ability to benefit from tourism industry depends on the availability of investments needed to develop the necessary infrastructures particularly access roads to facilitate comfort and convenience of incoming tourists;

**“WHEREAS**, the Department of Tourism-Department of Public Works and Highways (DOT-DPWH) convergence program known as Tourism Road Infrastructure Program (TRIP) promotes rural development towards increasing agricultural and rural enterprise productivity and community-based tourism. TRIP covers tourism road projects leading to airports and seaports and tourist destinations. The following local tourism access roads were identified by the LGU-Bulalacao to be of utmost priority; to wit:

- i. Opening/Concreting of Hinagdanan-Burungcaan Local Access Road      PhP 95M
- ii. Concreting of Imbuyungan-Kalong-Dakutan Local Access Road      50M
- iii. Concreting of Bagaw-Talibong Local Access Road Leading to Tourism Areas      50M
- iv. Concreting of San Juan-Quipanglao-Tambangan Local Access Road      95M
- v. Opening and Concreting of Quipanglao-Bugticol-Bangkal Local Access Road      50M
- vi. Opening and Concreting of Suryawon-Lagnas-Gatol Local Access Road      50M
- vii. Concreting of Gatol-Agong-Banti Local Access Road      95M


