**RESOLUTION NO. 21-03-121**

**RESOLUTION ENCOURAGING PRESIDENT RODRIGO ROA DUTERTE TO  
RUN THIS COMING 2022 NATIONAL ELECTION AS VICE PRESIDENT OF  
THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES**

“WHEREAS, Section 4 of Article VII of the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines states that “The President and the Vice-President shall be elected by direct vote of the people for a term of six years which shall begin at noon on the thirtieth day of June next following the day of the election and shall end noon of the same date, six years thereafter. The President shall not be eligible for any re-election. No person who has succeeded as President and has served as such for more than four years shall be qualified for election to the same office at any time”;

“WHEREAS, the next Philippine presidential and vice presidential elections are scheduled on Monday, May 9, 2022, and the Commission on Elections is expected to publish the list of official candidates by January 2022;

“WHEREAS, His Excellency President Rodrigo Roa Duterte was elected as the 16<sup>th</sup> President of the Republic of the Philippines on May 9, 2016 and began his term on June 30, 2016, since then his administration avidly improves the socioeconomic policies in which it referred as DuterteNomics that include tax reform, infrastructure development, social protection programs, and other policies promoting economic growth and human development in our country;

“WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro is in big support to the Duterte’s Administration, and is hoping that the good President would continue his enthusiasm to public service and that another national position such as of being the Vice President would keep up and enhance his developmental projects and programs for the nation;
