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RESOLUTION NO. 19-12- 266

DECLARING THE ENTIRE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACO, ORIENTAL MINDORO UNDER THE STATE OF CALAMITY DUE TO DEVASTATION CAUSED BY TYPHOON URSULA

"WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro suffered damages and various losses in agriculture, livestock and fishing industries caused by Typhoon Ursula which occurred on December 25, 2019 that brought distress, deep grief and misfortune among its inhabitants particularly the marginalized groups;

"WHEREAS, Typhoon Ursula brought strong winds and heavy rains to the entire Municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro for almost three (3) hours where an estimated 95% of the population were badly damaged, houses destructed reached to 5,493, 4 persons died, three (3) of them were crew from the boat going to Semirara Island and 4 persons were injured resulted to social and economic turmoil among the residents particularly the poor and the helpless families who were heavily affected by this natural calamity;

"WHEREAS, infrastructural facilities were devastated such as roads and bridges, electricity was totally shut-down and so as the communication network and the water supply system, hospitals and school buildings suffered 90% destruction among the LGU-funded school buildings while DepEd school buildings lost 20% ,oro port and the public market were also damaged and residential houses reached to 90% destruction;

"WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao declared this Municipality under the State of Calamity because of the initial reports submitted by the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office, the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office, the Municipal Agriculture Office and the Municipal Engineering Office showing remarkable losses in agriculture, infrastructure and fisheries;


WHEREAS, taking into account various damages caused by Typhoon Ursula in the Municipality of Bulalacao, it is with high hope that higher government agencies take priority to extend any form of assistance needed for its restoration and rehabilitation process for the social and economic benefits of its residents who suffered lots of stress and desperation; Now, therefore be it

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, TO: Declare the entire Municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro under the State of Calamity due to devastation caused by Typhoon Ursula;
