SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 06-09-18

ADOPTING THE PERTINENT PROVISION OF RA 7160 KNOWN AS THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991 WITH REGARDS TO REMITTANCE OF ANY MONIES RECEIVED AND COLLECTED TO THE NEAREST DEPOSITORY BANK TWICE A MONTH SIMULTANEOUS WITH THE TIME OF WITHDRAWAL OF THE SALARIES AND WAGES OF MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro:

SECTION 1. STATEMENT OF POLICY. In adherence to the provision of Article 450 stipulated under the Implementing Rules and Regulations of R.A. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 which says "Officers of Local Government Unit (LGU) authorized to receive and collect monies arising from taxes, revenues or receipts of any kind shall remit the full amount received and collected to the treasury of such LGU which shall be credited to the particular account or accounts to which the monies in question properly belong." In accordance therewith, the following regulated acts shall be strictly implemented, observed and followed by the accountable officers.


SECTION 2. Officers of LGU authorized to review and collect monies arising from taxes, revenues or receipts of any kind shall remit the full amount received and collected to the treasury of the Municipal Treasurers Office which shall be credited to the particular account or accounts to which the monies in question shall properly belong; further, in accordance with Article 542 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the same law the Municipal Treasurer shall maintain the depository account in the name of the Municipality of Bulalacao with banks, preferably government-owned, located in or nearest to its area of jurisdiction. Earnings of its depository account shall exclusively for the Municipality. The remittance of which shall be done twice a month simultaneous with the withdrawals for the salaries and wages of municipal officials and employees.


SECTION 3. Any violation thereof by any accountable officers shall be prosecuted and punished if found guilty in accordance with Republic Act 6713 "Anti-Graft and Corruption Law" and penalties imposed under Commission on Audit rules and regulations and other applicable laws.


SECTION 4. This special ordinance shall take effect immediately.




