SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 11-05-23

DECLARING THE ENTIRE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO UNDER THE STATE OF CALAMITY DUE TO THE GREAT LOSS SUSTAINED FROM LONG DROUGHT CAUSED BY EL NINO PHENOMENON

“WHEREAS, more than 70% of the population of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro is engaged in agriculture as a means of living; majority of them belong to the so-called marginal farmers;

“WHEREAS, as reported and verified by the Municipal Agricultural Office, the whole of Bulalacao was adversely affected by El Nino during the Dry Cropping Season of 2011; marginal fisherfolks were not spared as their catch suffered turned out to be exceedingly low;

“WHEREAS, unless and until the government steps in and introduces some remedial measures, these marginal sectors will be having dark days ahead of them as they already lost their little capital in investing for seeds and other agricultural inputs thus harming the total spectrum of our local economy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED as it is hereby ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro:

SECTION 1. The entire Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro is hereby declared to be under the State of Calamity due to the great loss sustained by the farmers and fisherfolks sustained from the long drought caused by the El Nino Phenomenon;


SEC. 2. Disbursements of the necessary fund from 5% Calamity Fund of this Municipality is hereby authorized subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations.


SEC. 3. This special ordinance shall take effect immediately.


