**RESOLUTION NO. 03-03-062**

**EARNESTLY REQUESTING HONORABLE JOSE D. LINA, SECRETARY, DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT, THRU HONORABLE EMELIA BONCODIN, SECRETARY, DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE BENEFITS OF BARANGAY OFFICIALS, STIPULATED UNDER SECTION 393 OF R.A 7160 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991**

**"WHEREAS,** it is under scored under section 393 of R.A 7160 that the punong barangay, the sangguniang barangay members, the barangay secretary, and the barangay treasurer shall also be entitled to Christmas bonus of at-least One Thousand Pesos (1,000) each. The funds for which shall be taken from the general fund of the barangay or from such other funds appropriated by the national government,(a) Be entitled, during their incumbency, to insurance coverage which shall include, but shall not be limited to temporary and permanent disability, double indemnity, accident insurance, death and burial benefits, in accordance with R.A No. 6942, entitled " **An Act Increasing the Insurance benefits of Local Government Officials and Providing Funds Therefor**"; (b) Be entitled to free medical care including subsistence, medicines and medical attendance in any government hospital or institution: Provided, that such hospital care shall include surgery or surgical expenses, medicines, X-ray, laboratory fees and other hospital expenses. In case of extreme urgency where

there is no available government hospital or institution, the barangay official concerned may submit himself for immediate medical attendance to the nearest private clinic, hospital or institution and the expenses not exceeding five thousand pesos (5,000) that may be incurred where in shall be chargeable against the funds of the barangay concerned;(4) Be exempted during their incumbency from paying tuition and matriculation fees for their legitimate dependent children attending state college or universities. He may likewise avail of such educational benefits in a state collage or universities located within the province or city to which the barangay belongs; and (5) Be entitled to appropriate civil service eligibility on the basis of the number of years of service to the barangay, pursuant to the rules and regulations issued by the Civil Service Commission.

**WHEREAS,** it is a blaring fact that local government units especially those of lowest level and located at rural areas. Do not possess the financial capability to ensure that the above benefits that can truly exercise for the benefits of barangay officials;

**WHEREAS,** it is a very sad observation that after rendering years in public as a barangay officials, they are face the reality that they have no pension to look for, despite they are truly served their constituents of fullest strength , and yet they are not receiving post compensation after their service;

**WHEREAS,** it is a virtual need that the state must provide certain financial assistance and pass a Law providing barangay officials with pension and other social benefits and privileges; Now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To:** Earnestly request the Honorable Jose D. Lina, Secretary, Department of Interior and Local Government, thru Honorable Emelia Boncudin, Secretary, Department of Budget and Management to appropriate funds for the benefits of barangay officials, stipulated under Section 393 of R.A 7160 otherwise knows as the local government code of 1991;
