EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE JAPANESE GOVERNMENT THRU MINISTER AKIO EGAWA, CONSUL GENERAL, JAPAN EMBASSY TO GRANT THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO WITH ONE (1) UNIT OF FIRETRUCK AND ONE (1) UNIT OF PATROL VEHICLE UNDER THE NON-PROJECT GRANT ASSISTANCE OF THE JAPAN'S OFFICIAL DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE

"WHEREAS, effective execution of the powers and functions of the Philippine National Police (PNP) stated under Section 24 of Republic Act No. 7160 is hampered in the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro due to lack of the necessary logistical support and transportation facilities particularly that of a fire truck and a patrol vehicle;

"WHEREAS, the Bulalacao PNP Station is in dire need of a service vehicle which would be used in the prevention of crimes, maintenance of peace and order and arrest of criminal offender for the social and economic benefits of the constituents;

"WHEREAS, equally important is the availability of a fire truck which would be readily used in the occurrence of dangerous calamities such as fire brought about by either natural or man-made calamities resulting to misfortune, agony and emptiness which might be prevented through sufficient knowledge and availability of equipment such as that of a fire truck;


"WHEREAS, considering the limited financial capacity of this Pro-Poor Municipality, it is possible to acquire the much needed logistical support facilities mentioned above that this Office is humbly requesting the Japan's Government through the benevolent Akio Egawa to kindly consider and understands so as to realize of herein noble request; Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: Earnestly request the Japanese Government thru Minister Akio Egawa, Consul General, Japan with one (1) unit of fire truck and one (1) unit of patrol vehicle under the Non-Project Grant Assistance of the Japan's Official Development Assistance;
