### RESOLUTION NO. 08-01-011

EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE ABS/CBN FOUNDATION TO PROVIDE THE TWENTY SEVEN (27) PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS AND THE FOUR (4) PUBLIC SECONDARY SCHOOLS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO WITH EDUCATION TELEVISION (ETV) PACKAGES TO MAXIMIZE THE USE OF MEDIA FOR THE BETTERMENT OF THE QUALITY OF EDUCATION IN THIS FAR-FLUNG MUNICIPALITY

"WHEREAS, it is a Constitutional mandate that the State shall assign the highest budgetary priority to education and that basic and quality education be made accessible to all;

"WHEREAS, albeit the fact that education gets the larger portion of our national budgetary pie, still most of our public schools are suffering from insufficiency of funds to enable them to deliver real quality education;

"WHEREAS, in a string of financial constraint related problems, there are several non-government and civic organizations showing philanthropic positive actions to help achieve our common goal, recognizing the importance that all people in their own communities or society are empowered to limit incidence of illiteracy;

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: Earnestly request the ABS/CBN Foundation to provide the twenty seven (27) Public Elementary Schools and the four (4) Public Secondary Schools of the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro with Education Television (ETV) packages to maximize the use of media for the betterment of the quality of education in the far-flung Municipality;


