EARNESTLY REQUESTING SENATOR BONG GO TO KINDLY COORDINATE WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT FOR THE ALLOCATION OF FUND AMOUNTING TO FIFTEEN MILLION PESOS (Php15,000,000.00) TO BE USED FOR THE CONCRETING OF SITIO BANTI-GATOL TO AGONG LOCAL ACCESS ROAD SITUATED IN BARANGAY SAN ROQUE, MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

“WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao is on its way to being an agro-eco-tourism destination in the Province of Oriental Mindoro that collaborative hard works from both government and private sectors are applied and gathered together to deliver the best positive outcome;

“WHEREAS, roadways serve a vital purpose in any places, it allows people and vehicles to traverse a diverse range of lands so that they can reach their destination without any hindrance and it is an important form of infrastructure that is ideal and necessary in the areas;
