RESOLUTION NO. 20-08-377

EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE PHILIPPINE HEALTH INSURANCE CORPORATION TO INCLUDE THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO IN ITS BENEFIT PACKAGE FOR TESTING SARS-COV-2 MANDATED UNDER PHILHEALTH CIRCULAR NO. 2020-0010 DATED APRIL 8, 2020

"WHEREAS, the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) is one with the nation fight against Covid-19. Under the Universal Health Care Act or Republic Act No. 11223, PhilHealth shall ensure equitable access to quality, affordable and accessible health care services by all Filipinos. By providing coverage for diagnostic tests, PhilHealth through PhilHealth Board Resolution No. 2516, s. 2020 shall cover the medical expenses for testing SARS-CoV-2;

"WHEREAS, according to World Health Organization (WHO), there are three (3) elements needed to fight the spread and transmission of Covid-19; these are mass testing, contact tracing, isolation and treatment;

"WHEREAS, during the implementation of Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ) in the Province of Oriental Mindoro particularly in the Municipality of Bulalacao, a big number of Locally Stranded Individuals (LSI) arrived without the strict implementation of the three elements mentioned above specifically the conduct of mass testing due to lack of funds;


