

SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 95-10-011

CONSTITUTING THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN AS A COMMITTEE OF A WHOLE TO MONITOR THE PROGRESS, RESULT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ENFORCED LEGISLATIVE MEASURES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro:

SECTION 1. The Sangguniang Bayan is hereby constituted as a Committee of a whole to be called as "Legislative Monitoring Committee hereinafter referred to as the Committee. The Chairman shall be determined through a majority vote by the members.

SECTION 2. OBJECTIVES. The Committee is created in order to:

- i. To determine whether the enacted measure is actually implemented or enforced by inquiring from the local government department or office tasked to implement or enforce the same;
- ii. In the case of an implemented or enforced measure, determine whether target population is familiar with said measure through a conduct of field surveys or random interviews of affected individuals;
- iii. Assess the effectiveness of an implemented or enforced measure through the conduct of dialogue with target beneficiaries and others involved in the implementation of the measure; and
- iv. Prepare a report. In case of negative feedbacks, recommend alternative option to the Sanggunian.

SECTION 3. POWERS AND FUNCTIONS.-The Committee shall have the following powers and functions:


- i. It shall evaluate the validity of an enacted Sanggunian measure in terms of satisfying the specific needs of the target group in the community from which such measure is addressed;

- ii. It may conduct researches in aid of local legislation;
- iii. It must undertake tracking and analysis of enacted ordinances and resolutions of lower level Sanggunian;
- iv. It shall prepare a report about the implementation of enforced measure and recommend alternative option in case such measure gets negative feedbacks;
- v. It shall conduct dialogue with target beneficiaries and other involved in the implementation of enforced measure in order to assist its effectiveness;
- vi. It shall determine whether target population is familiar with implemented or enforced measure through the conduct of field surveys or random interviews of affected individuals;
- vii. It shall determine whether the enacted measure is actually implemented or enforced by inquiring from the Local Government Department or Office tasked to implement or enforce the same.

SECTION 4. This special ordinance shall take effect immediately.
