"WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro is becoming popular to local and foreign tourists because of the beautiful islands and islets with powdery white sand beaches and crystal clear water where everyone could see and enjoy;

"WHEREAS, last month, the coastal areas of Bulalacao was contaminated by oil spill caused by MT Princess Empress which lead to severe disruption for the tourist industry. Contamination of coastal areas with high amenity value is a common feature of many oil spills. Serious economic losses can be experienced by industries and individuals dependent on coastal resources;


"WHEREAS, study shows that tourism significantly declined with oil spill and to save Bulalacao from this economic turmoil, an inspection and assessment of the safety of its coastal areas is necessary as basis of this LGU in its plan of declaring the Municipality free of oil spill as what the human eyes see however, scientific studies is more reliable than visual conclusion; Now, therefore, be it
