**AN ORDINANCE DECLARING EVERY FIRST WEEK OF SEPTEMBER
AS OFFICIAL BARANGAY WORKERS' WEEK IN THE MUNICIPALITY
OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO AND
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF FOR ITS CELEBRATION**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental
Mindoro:

WHEREAS, Section 384 of Republic Act No. 7160 also known as the
Local Government Code of 1991 states that as the basic political unit, the
barangay serves as the primary planning and implementing unit of
government policies, plans, programs, projects, and activities in the
community, and as a forum wherein the collective views of the people may
be expressed, crystallized and considered, and where disputes may be
amicably settled;

WHEREAS, Chapter 4, Section 393 (d) of the LGC provides that all duly appointed members of the barangay tanod brigades or their equivalent, which number shall not be more than twenty (20) in each barangay, shall be granted insurance or other benefits during their incumbency, chargeable to the barangay of the city or municipal government to which the barangay belongs;

WHEREAS, Republic Act 7883 was enacted into law in February 1995 which is an Act granting benefits and incentives to accredited Barangay Health Workers and for other purposes;

WHEREAS, Bulalacao is a 3rd class municipality hounded with financial constraints which is located at the southernmost tip of the province of Oriental Mindoro, has a population of 44,366 based on 2020 census, consist of 15 barangays being directly govern by its barangay officials with the help and assistance of its barangay appointed employees and workers;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao acknowledges the sacrifices and services rendered by the barangay workers such as the Barangay Health Workers, Barangay Justice, Barangay Tanods, Barangay Nutrition Scholars and Day Care Workers that accrued to the progress and development of all the barangays in this municipality, thus, it is only proper that they be given due recognition by having a special week for them to celebrate;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, as it is hereby ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro, that:

Section 1. Statement of Policy. It is the policy of the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao to recognize the role and importance of the barangay workers in maintaining public order, protection and security of life and property of each barangay, and in helping the barangay officials in enhancing the delivery of basic services and development to all barangays of this municipality.

Section 2. Title. This Ordinance is entitled as stated and shall be also known as the "2024 Barangay Workers' Week Ordinance of Bulalacao".

Section 3. Definition of Terms. As used in this ordinance, the following terms shall mean:

- a. **Barangay Worker** refers to all appointed barangay workers specifically the Barangay Health Workers, Barangay Justice, Barangay Tanods, Barangay Nutrition Scholars and Day Care Workers of the fifteen barangays of Bulalacao.
- b. **BHW** refers to the Barangay Health Workers of the fifteen barangays of Bulalacao who shall be in charged in providing basic health education and selected primary health care services and link clients from their respective barangays to health facilities.


- c. **BNS** refers to the Barangay Nutrition Scholars of the fifteen barangays of Bulalacao who shall be responsible in delivering basic nutrition and related health services, and link clients from their respective barangays to nutrition and related service providers.
- d. **Barangay Tanod** refers to a civilian volunteer who assist the barangay officials in the effective exercises of law enforcement for the maintenance of peace and order and the promotion of public safety to the barangay.
- e. **Barangay Justice** refers to a member of a local justice system who provides a friendly, inexpensive and speed forum for the settlement of disagreements within the barangay where the parties can freely explore options for amicably resolving their disputes without resorting to the courts.
- f. **Day Care Worker** refers to individuals who look after children before and after school or while parents are working, they help establish and enforce schedules or routines, assist with feeding and cleaning children, and encourage learning and socialization.
- g. **Barangay Secretary and Barangay Treasurer** refer to other appointed barangay workers who can be included in the celebration of Barangay Workers' Week but excluded in granting cash gift as prescribed in this Ordinance.


Section 4. Barangay Workers' Week. Under the supervision of the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao, the Barangay Workers' Week shall have the following event:


- a. Creation of Barangay Workers' Week Committee – several committees shall be formed each year from the barangay officials and employees from the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao to ensure organized and exquisite result of this special week for the barangay workers.
- b. Parade – on the first day of the Barangay Workers' Week there shall have a parade of all the barangay workers of Bulalacao.
- c. Day Care Worker's Day – on the first day after the parade, there shall have a set of activities intended only for Day Care Workers of Bulalacao.
- d. BHW Day – on the second day of the Barangay Workers' Week there shall have a set of activities intended only for the Barangay Health Workers of Bulalacao.
- e. BNS Day – on the third day of the Barangay Workers' Week there shall have a set of activities intended only for the Barangay Nutrition Scholars of Bulalacao.
