## RESOLUTION NO. 06-07-075

EARNESTLY REQUESTING HONORABLE ALFONSO V. UMALI, JR., CONGRESSMAN, 2<sup>ND</sup> DISTRICT, ORIENTAL MINDORO TO FACILITATE THE SEPARATION AND CONVERSION OF BULALACAO NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL SAN ROQUE ANNEX SITUATED AT BARANGAY SAN ROQUE FROM THE BULALACAO NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL MAIN BOTH ARE SITUATED AT THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

**"WHEREAS**, it is a Constitutional mandate that the State shall protect and promote the right of all citizens to quality education at all levels and shall take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all. It shall establish, maintain and support a complete, adequate and integrated system of education relevant to the needs of the people and society;

**"WHEREAS**, pursuant to the abovementioned constitutional mandate, the Municipal Government of Bulalacao initiated the establishment and operation of San Roque National High School Annex at Barangay San Roque to cater the elementary graduate from Barangays San Roque and San Juan and its nearby sitios;

**"WHEREAS**, the establishment and operation of the abovementioned secondary school in 2002 up to the present by the Municipal Government of Bulalacao redound to the social and economic benefits of both the parents and students alike that give this local government unit the courage to pursue even faced with financial difficulties and sacrifice some of its developmental projects;

"WHEREAS, it shall be to the convenience of this Pro-Poor Municipality if San Roque National High School be separated from the Bulalacao National High School Main for the operating expenses thereat be funded by the national government; Now, therefore, be it
