RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY TO INCLUDE TABLAS STRAIT AND MINDORO STRAIT PARTICULARLY THE PARTS THAT TRAVERSE THE MUNICIPAL WATERS OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO IN THE LIST OF TIDAL ENERGY POTENTIAL SITES IN THE COUNTRY

“WHEREAS, tidal energy is a renewable source of energy that is produced by the surge of ocean waters during the rise and fall of tides; progressive countries like South Korea, France, United Kingdom, Canada, Belgium, China, and Sweden are at high interest to use this instead of the fuel energy source;

“WHEREAS, the Department of Energy identified 8 potential tidal energy sites in the Philippines, namely: Bohol Strait, Basiao Channel, Surigao Strait, Gaboc Channel, Hinatuan Passage, San Bernardino Strait, Basilan Strait, and San Juanico Strait;
