**RESOLUTION REQUESTING SENATOR CHRISTOPHER LAWRENCE
"BONG" GO TO PROVIDE 50 TENTS AND 500 HYGIENE KITS TO
AUGMENT THE MUCH NEEDED HOSPITAL FACILITIES AND OTHER
MEDICAL SUPPLIES INTENDED FOR COVID- 19 PATIENTS IN THE
MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO**

"WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 states that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare, within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall promote health and safety;

"WHEREAS, on April 20, 2021, the Department of Health-RITM certified laboratory released that there are 953,106 total number of COVID-19 cases in the Philippines since the pandemic had started, the 2,324 cases recorded came from the Province of Oriental Mindoro;

"WHEREAS, it has been more than a year since the COVID- 19 pandemic had started and our country is still fighting the spread of the coronavirus; news and public announcements have stated the scarcity of hospital facilities and medical supplies that are needed for COVID- 19 patients all throughout the country;

"WHEREAS, Bulalacao is a 3rd class Municipality hounded with financial constraints located at the southernmost tip of the Province of Oriental Mindoro, has a population of 39, 107 based on 2015 census, 25 percent of which are indigenous people called Hanunuo Mangyan, has a municipal government that uplift the general health condition of the people;

"WHEREAS, having an exhausted fund, the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao arduously facing the shortage of hospital facilities and medical supplies to help its COVID- 19 patients and those having other sicknesses, and the provision of 50 tents and 500 hygiene kits are of utmost importance ;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: Request Senator Christopher Lawrence "Bong" Go to provide 50 tents and 500 hygiene kits to augment to augment the much needed hospital facilities and medical supplies intended for COVID-19 patients in the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro.
