EARNESTLY REQUESTING LIEUTENANT COMMANDER EUGENIO FEDERICO, STATION COMMANDER, PHILIPPINE COAST GUARD, ORIENTAL MINDORO TO FACILITATE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF PHILIPPINE COAST GUARD SUB-STATION IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO AND TO ASSIGN AT LEAST FOUR (4) ADDITIONAL PERSONNEL TO THE CURRENT BULALACAO COAST GUARD COMMAND POST

"WHEREAS, the Philippine Coast Guard also known as Tanod Baybayin ng Pilipinas is an armed and uniformed service tasked primarily with enforcing laws within Philippine waters, conducting maritime security operations, safeguarding life and property at sea and protecting marine environment and resources;

"WHEREAS, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro is a coastal Municipality with RoRo Port and Fish Port which are both operational that the services of the Philippine Coast Guard is needed for the continuous maritime patrol to ensure the safety of the general public;


"WHEREAS, at present, there are certain Coast Guard personnel detailed in Bulalacao stationed in a temporary station that the establishment of the Philippine Coast Guard Sub-Station at this Municipality shall enhance and improve the maritime services needed; Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: Earnestly request Lieutenant Commander Eugenio Federico, Station Commander, Philippine Coast Guard, Oriental Mindoro to facilitate the establishment of Philippine Coast Guard Sub-Station in the Municipality of Bulalacao and to assign at least four (4) additional personnel to the current Bulalacao Coast Guard Command Post;


