EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE PHILIPPINE COCONUT AUTHORITY (PCA) TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE COCONUT FARMERS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO TO BE USED FOR THE REHABILITATION AND RESTORATION OF COCONUT INDUSTRY WHICH WERE HEAVILY DAMAGED BY SUPER TYPHOON URSULA

"WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro was hit by a series of typhoons in December 2019; Typhoon Tisoy occurred on December 3 and super Typhoon Ursula on December 25 with strong winds and heavy rains ruined various infrastructural facilities such as roads and bridges, houses were washed-out and dilapidated, hospitals, public market and school buildings were destroyed including communication facilities and equipments and the water supply system;

"WHEREAS, a remarkable losses in agriculture and fishing industries were reported by the by the Municipal Agriculture Office in addition to the devastation of the banana plantation, bamboos and coconut industry seemed to vanish resulting to the feelings of depression and misfortune among the coconut farmers;

"WHEREAS, hoping for the assistance from the Philippine Coconut Authority (PCA) tasked to develop the coconut and palm oil industries and ensure that coconut farmers become direct participants in and beneficiaries of such developments, procurement and distribution of supplies and materials required for the massive rehabilitation of the affected areas be made possible soon; Now, therefore be it....
