

ORDINANCE NO. 020

SECTION AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 6, SERIES OF 1992

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 6, series of 1992 entitled "An ordinance regulating speed limitations along Provincial Road, specifically from Foursquare, Campaasan and all municipal streets" is hereby amended to read as follows:

"WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan is resolved to adopt speed restriction measure to prevent any person to drive any motor vehicle upon the Provincial Road particularly from the front of Barangay Hall, Campaasan and all Municipal Streets at such a speed as to endanger the life, limb and property of any person;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan has observed the rampant practice among drivers to drive at a speed that endangers the property, safety and the rights of the people;

WHEREAS, in order to regulate the flow of traffic and the safety of the people and the property, the Sangguniang Bayan do hereby ordains that:

SECTION 1. The maximum speed limit for any vehicle travelling the provincial road from the front of Barangay Hall of Campaasan and Bulalacao National High School shall be ten (10 kph;

SEC. 2. EXEMPTIONS. The rate of speed hereinabove prescribed shall not apply to the following:

- a. A physician or his driver when the former responds to emergency call;
- b. Any driver bringing a wounded or sick persons for emergency treatment to a hospital, clinic or any other similar places;
- c. The driver of a motor vehicle belonging to the Armed Forces while in times of riot, insurrection or invasion;
- d. A law enforcement officer who is trying to overtake a violator of traffic laws;

- e. The driver of a vehicle when he or his passengers is in pursuit of criminal and;

SECTION 3. Any person who violates any provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by:

- a. Fine of One Hundred Pesos (P100.00) an imprisonment of thirty days (30) or both at the discretion of the court for the first offense;
- b. A fine of Three Hundred Pesos (P300.00) an imprisonment of seventy five days (75) or both at the discretion of the court for the second offense;
- c. A fine of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P2,500.00) an imprisonment of six (6) months or both at the discretion of the court for third time habitual offenders.

SEC. 4. The conviction of any person for any offense under this Ordinance shall not bar his prosecution for any other offense which may have been committed by such person concurrently with the commission of the offense of which he was convicted or in doing, a series of acts which constituted the offense of which he was convicted;

SEC. 5. The Municipal Government through the Office of the Mayor in coordination with the Philippine National Police shall cause the execution of this Ordinance;

SEC. 6. Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly;

SEC. 7. This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days immediately after its passage.

RESOLVED FURTHER, That a copy of this ordinance be forwarded the Philippine National Police, Bulalacao Station and BTODA President, Campaasan, Bulalacao, Or. Mindoro
