EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE HONORABLE MANUEL G. ANDAYA, CONGRESSMAN, 2ND DISTRICT, ORIENTAL MINDORO TO FILE A BILL IN CONGRESS CREATING SAN ROQUE NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO AND ALLOCATING NECESSARY FUNDS THEREFOR

"WHEREAS, it is a Constitutional mandate that the State shall give priority to education, science and technology, arts, culture and sports to foster patriotism and nationalism. It further provides that the State shall assign the highest budgetary priority to education and that quality education be made available to all;

"WHEREAS, quality education could only be achieved through the provision of right and adequate facilities to tap the student's potentials to the fullest enabling them to cope up effectively with the increasingly technological world of computer era;


"WHEREAS, there is only one secondary school in this Municipality that the establishment of another one in Barangay San Roque would ease the difficulties of the students there to enroll in the nearby high school in Manual, Municipality of Mansalay;

"WHEREAS, the establishment of San Roque National High School shall cater elementary graduates of the adjacent barangays and nearby sitios to the benefits of the students and parents alike; Now, therefore, be it


