RECOMMENDING AND ENDORSING TO THE HONORABLE MANUEL G. ANDAYA, CONGRESSMAN, 2ND DISTRICT, ORIENTAL MINDORO THE PROPOSED CREATION OF BARANGAY YUNOT AT THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, THIS PROVINCE

"WHEREAS, Section 386 of R.A 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 and Article 14 of its Implementing Rules and Regulations provide that a barangay may be created in the indigenous cultural communities by an Act of Congress upon recommendation of the local government unit where the cultural community is located;

"WHEREAS, Sitio Yunot at Barangay Nasucob, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro expressed its desire to be created as a new barangay by virtue of Resolution No. 01 series of 1999 which was submitted to this Sanggunian for recommendations;

"WHEREAS, Sitio Yunot and sixteen (16) adjacent sitios of Barangays Nasucob, San Juan and Benli, Bulalacao, this Province are composed mostly of Hanunuo-Mangyans are desirous of becoming a new barangay in order to benefit the basic services which they claimed are deprived of them;


