“WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao is located in the southernmost tip of the Province of Oriental Mindoro whose population is composed of approximately 20% Hanunuo Mangyans;

“WHEREAS, Bulalacao is left behind in terms of modern technology such as a good transportation and communication systems primarily due to its distance from the capital City of Calapan and its geographical location; it is surrounded with high mountain ranges and sea waters;




