**EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE HONORABLE RAUL S. ROCO, SECRETARY, DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO FACILITATE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF MAUJAO AND SAN ROQUE NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOLS BOTH AT THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO**

“WHEREAS, it is a Constitutional mandate that the State shall give priority to education, science and technology, arts, culture and sports to foster patriotism, nationalism and development. It further provides that the State shall assign the highest budgetary priority to education and that quality and basic education be made accessible to all;

“WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro is a Pro-Poor Municipality pursuant to Executive Order No. 370, sincerely believes that education of its young men and women shall be the fundamental link to progress;
