RESOLUTION NO. 17-04-110

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE THRU ITS OIC-REGIONAL EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, LOUELLA ROWENA G. LORENZANA, PH.D., REGION IV-MIMAROPA TO CONDUCT SITE INSPECTION AND VALIDATION OF AREAS IN BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO THAT MAY BE INSTALLED WITH SOLAR-POWERED IRRIGATION SYSTEM

“WHEREAS, the solar-powered irrigation system is launched by the Department of Agriculture for areas that do not have irrigation system with a capacity to pump from 400 to 1000 gallons of water a day for up to 150 hectares of rice farm. It will help farmers who do not have access to water source and live far from the power grid. The irrigation system can draw out water from as deep as 1200 feet. Its goal is achieving sufficient rice supply and contribute to greater food production to address poverty and malnutrition in countryside;

“WHEREAS, in some particular places in Bulalacao with communal irrigation system allow farmers to plant rice twice a year, but rest of rice lands are rain-fed only that farmers plant rice only once a year;

“WHEREAS, with this solar-powered irrigation system farmers will no longer worry about the cost of producing water through diesel fuel water pump and be able to make sure that un-irrigated areas can have a second cropping. Likewise, this will not only benefit rice farmers but also other high value crops in upland areas in Bulalacao; Now, therefore, be it


RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: Request the Department of Agriculture thru its OIC-Regional Executive Director, Louella Rowena G. Lorenzana, Ph.D., Region IV-MIMAROPA to conduct site inspection and validation of areas in Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro that may be installed with solar-powered irrigation system;




