WHEREAS, the present administration is focus to expand access and
ensuring more Filipinos receive a decent basic education, and to enhance the
current educational system, as a means of reducing poverty and improving
national competitiveness;

WHEREAS, Bulalacao is 3rd class municipality hounded with financial
constraints, has a municipal government that promotes, upholds, and supports
Education for All advocacy, the updated number of schools within the
municipality are 46 elementary schools including extensions, 2 of which are
newly established and 22 high schools including extensions, 3 of which are
newly established;

constructed recently to cater the growing population of young learners and
students in all barangays of the municipality especially those in geographically
isolated and depressed areas;


