RESOLUTION NO. 19-11-222

EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR CULTURE AND ARTS TO ESTABLISH HANUNUO MANGYAN SCHOOL OF LIVING TRADITION IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

“WHEREAS, the establishment of School of Living Tradition (SLT) is also anchored on the mandate of the National Commission for Culture and Arts to conserve and promote the nation's historical and cultural heritage and to preserve and integrate traditional culture and its various creative expressions as a dynamic part of the national cultural mainstream;

“WHEREAS, a School of Living Tradition is one where a living master/culture bearer or culture specialist teaches skills and techniques of doing a traditional art or craft; the mode of teaching is usually non-formal, oral and with practical demonstrations;

“WHEREAS, the SLT program generally aims to provide a venue where a culture specialist or master who embodies the skills and techniques of a particular traditional art form imparts to a group of interested youth the skills and techniques of such form. Specifically the program aims to identify components of traditional culture and arts considered to be important to a cultural community and have to be transferred to the young so that these aspects can be perpetuated;

“WHEREAS, approximately 20% of the population of the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro is composed of Hanunuo Mangyans most of them living in the hinterland but facing challenges of modern ways of living, hence; preservation of culture and tradition is indeed necessary;

"WHEREAS, this Municipality recognizes the important role and contributions of Hanunuo Mangyans in the promotion of tourism industry through their authentic, arts and culture, tradition and practices, language, and poetry and as such it sincerely consider the importance of establishing a Hanunuo Mangyan School of Living Tradition in Bulalacao; **Now, therefore, be it**




