ORDINANCE NO. 07-11-75

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE TRAFFIC RULES AND REGULATIONS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR ANY TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS THAT MAY BE COMMITTED WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO

"WHEREAS, pursuant to R.A. 7160, Article III, Section 447 (V) & (VI) state that the Sangguniang Bayan shall regulate the use of streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks, bridges, parks and other public places and approve the construction, improvement, repair and maintenance of the same; establish bus and vehicles stops and terminals or regulate the use of the same by privately owned vehicle which serve the public; regulate garage and the operation of conveyances for hire; designate stands to be occupied by public vehicles when not in use; regulate the putting-up of signs, sign post awnings and awning post on the streets, and provide for the lighting, cleaning and sprinkling of streets and public places, regulate traffic in all streets and bridges, prohibit the putting-up of encroachment of obstacles thereon, and when necessary in the interest of public welfare, authorize the removal of encroachment and illegal construction in public places;

"WHEREAS, any traffic infractions that may be committed within the road network and national is subject to corresponding measure or penalties;

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: Enact Municipal Ordinance No. 07-11-75, to wit:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the Traffic Rules and Regulations in the Municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro;

SEC. 2. That the Traffic Rules and Regulations prescribed in this Ordinance must be strictly observed as follows:

SEC. 2-a. From 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., F. Atienza Street (Northwest of the town proper) is hereby declared as One Way Traffic to all passengers/private vehicles, tricycles, motorbikes and all kinds of vehicles entering Poblacion, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro and A. Salas Street (Northeast of the town proper) One Way Traffic to all kinds of vehicles leaving this Municipality;

SEC. 2-b. Loading and Unloading

- For buses, jeepneys and other four wheeled passenger vehicles – right side of A. Salas St. facing Maka's Residence and A. Salas St. near Buhay Cueto Bakery.

SEC. 2-c. Parking Area

- The portion of the open space west of the Public Market of Bulalacao is hereby designated as Permanent Parking Space for passenger buses, jeepneys, multi-cabs and cargo trucks.
- In front of Municipal Terminal at Barangay Campaasan is designated Parking Area for all passenger tricycles and passenger single motorcycles.

SEC. 2-d. No Parking Area

- Along A. Salas St. is designated No Parking Area for all passenger vehicles and cargo trucks.

SEC. 2-e. That Traffic signboards shall be placed to all designated areas.

SEC. 3. Traffic violations and corresponding fines:

SEC. 4. Portion of A. Salas St. going South from the end of J. Templanza St. down to Road going to Pier shall be One Way Traffic to all kinds of vehicles going to Pier and all vehicles coming from the Pier shall take the route to Magallanes St. passing R. Bago St. then to A. Salas St. leaving the town proper.

- SEC. 5. J. Templanza St. is One Way Traffic to all kinds of vehicles
- G. Pantilo St. is Two Way Traffic to all kinds of vehicles
- C. Bendolo St. is Two Way Traffic to all kinds of vehicles
- R. Bago St. is One Way Traffic to all kinds of vehicles
- V. Magallanes St. is One Way Traffic to all kinds of vehicles
- G. Contreras St. is Two Way Traffic to all kinds of vehicles
- A. Montero St. is One Way Traffic to all kinds of vehicles
- A. Pajado St. is Two Way Traffic to all kinds of vehicles

SEC. 6. Receipt. The Traffic violator receipt issued to violators are considered an accountable form and any amount derived thereon shall accrue to the Trust Fund of the Municipality of Bulalacao that may be allotted for any development activities of traffic enforcement and management. It should be prepared in triplicate, the original copy for the violator, the duplicate copy for PNP Traffic Enforcers and last copy for the Office of the Municipal Treasurer.

SEC. 7. All PNP are hereby given the authority to take possession of driver's license/for plate number of motor vehicle of violator or impound subject vehicle but in no case shall remain in custody of the same upon payment of the corresponding fine for traffic infraction committed, and or upon securing/renewing pertinent papers needed to motor vehicle.

SEC. 8. The Traffic Violation Receipt is valid within three (3) days from the date of issue to the traffic violator and it will serve as his/her temporary driver's license/plate number and to be responsible to pay at the Municipal Treasurer's Office of this Municipality within the three (3) days period.

SEC. 9. Any traffic violators who failed to comply within the three (3) day reglamentary period shall be filed criminal charges before the Municipal Circuit Trial Court, Mansalay, Oriental Mindoro for violation of this Ordinance;

SEC. 10. Repealing Clause. All ordinances which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SEC. 11. Separability Clause. If for reason (s) any provisions of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid other provisions hereof are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.


SEC. 12. Penalty Clause. Any violation of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php2,500.00) or imprisonment not exceeding six (6) months or both at the discretion of the Court.


SEC. 13. Effectivity Clause. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.


SEC. 10. Repealing Clause. All ordinances which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
