MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 21-02-287

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING DUE RECOGNITION AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE FORMER MUNICIPAL ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF BULALACAO AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF

WHEREAS, Article XI, Section I of the Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines provides that Public Office is a Public Trust. Public Officers must at all times be accountable to the people, serve them with utmost responsibility, integrity, loyalty and efficiency; act with patriotism and justice, and lead modest lives;

WHEREAS, the General Welfare Clause of the Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines provides that the promotion of the general welfare is essential for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessings of democracy;

WHEREAS, also Article III Section 447 (a) of the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that the Sangguniang Bayan, as the legislative body of the Municipality, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the Municipality and its inhabitants;

WHEREAS, also Title One Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its effective and efficient governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao to recognize the sacrifices and services rendered by any person that redound to its progress and development especially those who have served in their capacity as elected local government officials;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao acknowledged the sacrifices and services rendered by its former elected officials, thus, it is only appropriate that they be given due recognition and financial assistance;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF BULALACAO IN SESSION ASSEMBLED THAT;

Section 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be known and cited as **“AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING DUE RECOGNITION AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO FORMER ELECTED MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS OF THE LGU OF BULALACAO”**

Section 2. REQUIREMENTS and PROCEDURE: Before a former elected Municipal Official can be recognized and given the appurtenant recognition and financial assistance, the following conditions shall be complied with:

- a. For a former Municipal Mayor, he/she must submit before the Office of the Municipal Mayor a letter of intent to avail the benefits of this Ordinance and a certification that he/she had completed a one (1) term in the said position which may be provided by the Human Resource Management Unit;
- b. For a former Vice-Mayor, he/she must submit before the Office of the Municipal Mayor a letter of intent to avail the benefits of this Ordinance and a certification he/she had completed a one (1) term in the said position which may be provided by the Human Resource Management Unit or the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan;
- c. For a former Member of the Sangguniang Bayan, he/she must submit before the Office of the Municipal Mayor a letter of intent to avail the benefits of this Ordinance and a certification that he/she has held the said position for an aggregate number of years totaling to nine (9) years which may be provided by the Human Resource Management Unit or the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan;
- d. Upon submission of proper and authentic documents, the Municipality of Bulalacao will grant each of the recipient an amount based on the following;
 - Former Municipal Mayor PhP 3,000.00 every last day of the month
 - Former Vice-Mayor 2,000.00 every last day of the month
 - Former Member of the Sangguniang Bayan 1,000.00 every last day of the month
- e. In case the former elected municipal official has held various elective positions, he/she may only avail of the benefits given to the highest office he/she held;
- f. The financial assistance may be granted as long as the recipient is alive and the same shall not be transferable;

Section 3. Disbursement. In case the recipient is not capable to receive the financial assistance in person, the same shall be disbursed in his/her place of residence and the payroll shall be prepared by the Office of the Municipal Mayor.

Section 4. SPECIAL RECOGNITION. The former elected municipal official who have reached the age of one hundred (100) years or more shall be recognized and be given due recognition on the date of the occasion set by the Office of the Municipal Mayor, his/her remarkable stories shall be published in any local newspaper or other social communications like radio stations, and website, among others, and be given a financial assistance in the amount of One Hundred Thousand (PhP100,000.00).

Section 5. Appropriation. The grant of this recognition and financial assistance shall be based upon the availability of funds for the current year. However, in the next Fiscal Year and thereafter, the fund should be included in the Annual General Appropriation of the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao.

Appropriation for Former Members of the Sangguniang Bayan who have not completed an aggregate number of years totally to nine (9) years should always be considered priority and be given utmost preference in the enactment of ordinances for the next Fiscal Year.


Section 6. Repealing Clause. All existing ordinances, resolutions, local executive orders and other rules and regulations which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.

Section 7. Separability Clause. Should any of these clauses or parts of the ordinance be declared unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, all other remaining portions not so affected shall remain valid and in effect.


Section 8. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.




