RESOLUTION NO. 8  
ORDINANCE NO. 1

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR ITS VIOLATION THEREOF, TO ANY PERSON,  
OR PERSONS, ANY INDIVIDUAL, WHO IS OR ARE BEING INTOXICATED WITH ANY  
FERMENTED LIQUORS AS TUBA, ANY OTHER BEVERAGES TO BE SEEN, ENTERED  
IN COCKPIT PREMISES WITHIN TWENTY METERS RADIOUS AND/OR INSIDE THE  
COCKPIT KING:

Be it ordained by the municipal Council of Bulalagao,

That:-

Section 1.- That no person or persons, any other individual who is  
or are allowed within twenty meters radious and/or inside the cockpit ring  
being drunkard, intoxicated with any alcoholic liquors as tuba, any other  
beverages to be seen and shall be seen in cockpit premises and/or entering  
inside the cockpit ring, making scandalous acts or acts, discoloring, making  
noise, troubles, any other malicious acts of intention to disturb the  
tranquillity of any person or persons, any other individual, be charged  
for INTOXICATION.

Section 2.- It is also likewise prohibited and unlawful acts for any  
persons or persons, any other individual who is or are being intoxicated,  
to carry any deadly weapons such as balisong, bolo and other sharp  
instruments or materials; especially guns, revolvers or any other pistol  
with high caliber: P r o v i d e d, that only peace officers such as PC  
personnel, police forces or other officials authorized to carry pistols  
with high power caliber for maintaining peace and order;

Section 3.- It shall be unlawful for any person, proprietor, vendor,  
operator or other individual to bring, carry, deposit, place, display any  
alcoholic liquors or any kind of beverage inside the cockpit ring and  
within fifty meters radious from the cockpit ring;

Any ordinance or part thereof, inconsistent  
with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be null and void.

Section 5.- PENALTY: For any violation or part thereof of the provisions  
of this ordinance, having been caught violating the stipulated provisions  
as embodied in this ordinance, any person or persons, proprietor, vendor,  
operator, any other individual shall upon conviction for its offense be  
punished by a fine of not less than five (P5.00) pesos and not more than  
twenty-five pesos (P25.00) and imprisonment of not less than five (5) days  
and not more than ten (10) days or both such fine and imprisonment in the  
discretion of the Court.

Section 6.- WHEN TO TAKE EFFECT: This Ordinance shall take effect after  
ten (10) days of its passage.
