MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO HELD ON MAY 4, 1981 AT THE MUNICIPAL SESSION HALL.

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 O'clock in the morning.

The calling of the roll was performed by the Recorder with the members answering present when their respective names were called.

The minutes of the previous meeting was also read by the Recorder and there no objection so on motion of Hon. Edilberto M. Pajila, seconded by Hon. Perpetuo C. Cantos, the minutes stands as confirmed.

Following the rules of procedure the meeting was suspended at 10:00 O'clock AM on motion of Hon. Modesto O. Bacawag, seconded by Hon. Wilfredo J. Eabile, to entertain some Barangay Captains in this Municipality who appeared personally before this body to present their respective problems regarding the release of the ₱5,000.00 for their barangay projects. Barangay Captains, Usig Garing of Benli, Miguel Panum of San Miguel said that their projects are not constructed due to lack of materials and the delay of the release of fund for the labor of said project. They said MLCGD, Melencio Faminialagao promised them to give the amount but until now, the same was not given to them.

In view of the above, Barangay Captains Usig Garing, Miguel Panum and Mar Astillo of Barangay Maasin Executed their respective affidavits stating the delay of the delivery of construction materials and the release of funds for the labor of said projects.

The SB Secretary was ordered by the Sangguniang Bayan to write Mr. Melencio Faminialagao to request the same to attend the Special meeting of this Body on May 20, 1981 for that purpose.

Two checks purposely for the maintenance of Municipal streets of this town amounting to ₱10,000.00 and ₱3,335.00 respectively was presented to this body by Mayor Dolores S. Bago. The town executive said the province also give ₱20,000.00 as Aid to the Municipality of Bulalacao for additional maintenance of Municipal Streets.

RESOLVED, to approve the following Ordinance:

ORDINANCE NO. 7 ✓

ORDINANCE NO.

REQUIRING ALL PERSONS, BUSINESSMEN, COMPANIES, CORPORATION, ASSOCIATION, ETC,
TO SECURE MAYOR'S PERMIT BEFORE TRANSPORTING ROLLS OF GARLIC, BASKETS OF BANANAS,
SACKS OR BASKETS OF DRIED OR FRESH FISH OF ANCHOVIS (BISLAD) ETC, FROM
THIS MUNICIPALITY TO OTHER MUNICIPALITIES OUTSIDE OR WITHIN THE PROVINCE, FOR
HOME CONSUMPTION OR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES

WHEREAS, it has been observed that tolles of garlic, baskets, of bananas,
baskets of dried or fresh fish of anchovis, etc, had been transferred to other
Municipalities without Mayor's Permits or tickets thereof;

WHEREAS, in order to raise the revenue of this Municipality, the Sangguniang
Bayan of Bulalacao, hereby Ordains that:

SECTION 1. All persons, businessmen, companies, corporation, Association,
etc, are hereby required to secure Mayor's Permit in the amount of P5.00 in the
office of the Mayor before transporting rolls of garlic, baskets of bananas, baskets
or sacks of fresh or dried fish (bislad) or anchovis, etc, to other Municipalities,
outside or within the province for home consumption or commercial purposes;

SECTION 2. Owner or owners of the products mentioned above aside from the
Mayor's Permit to transport, shall also secure cash tickets in the amount of P.25
per kilo in the case of fresh or dried fish and rolls of garlic and P1.00 per baskets
or sacks of bananas, etc, before transporting the same to other municipalities
thereof;

SECTION 3.- Violation of the provisions of this Ordinance or parts thereof
shall be fined the amount of P25.00 to P200.00 and an imprisonment of 15 days to
30 days or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court;

Section 4.- Ordinance or Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly;

Section 5.- This Ordinance shall effect immediately upon its passage.
