RESOLUTION NO. 03-10-150

EARNESTLY REQUESTING HER EXCELLENCY GLORIA MACAPAGAL ARROYO, PRESIDENT, REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES TO ABOLISH THE PURCHASED POWER ADJUSTMENT (PPA) FOR THE INTERESTS AND WELFARE OF THE CONSUMING PUBLIC

"WHEREAS, it is sadly observed that almost 50% of the electric bills goes to the Purchased Power Adjustment or PPA which is attributed by the unconsumed electricity or by an electricity which was not actually produced and supplied;

"WHEREAS, the inclusion of PPA in electric bills is a violation of human rights pursuant to the Advisory CHR (III)-A-002-2002 of the Commission on Human Rights and Article II, Section 9 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution which provides that the State shall promote a just and dynamic social order that will ensure the prosperity and independence of the nation and free the people from poverty through policies that provide adequate social services, promote full employment, a rising standard of living, and an improved quality of life for all;


"WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro is a Pro-Poor Municipality whose population is composed of approximately 20% Hanunuo Mangyans who lived below poverty level, the Christian residents solely depend their living on fishing and farming who do not have better access to meet their minimum basic needs that increasing rate of electric bills is an added burden;

"WHEREAS, in consideration of the social and economic benefits of every Filipino citizen and in order to protect and promote individual interest and welfare, the Purchased Power Adjustment charged against them must be abolished; Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED: To: Earnestly request Her Excellency Gloria Macapagal Arroyo, President, Republic of the Philippines to abolish the Purchased Power Adjustment (PPA) for the interests and welfare of the consuming public;
