JESUS EMMANUEL PARAS, UNDERSECRETARY FOR OPERATIONS, FISHERIES AND LIVESTOCKS TO ALLOCATE THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY MILLION PESOS (PHP20M) TO BE USED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF FISH MARKET TRADING HALL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO






