RESOLUTION NO. 21-06-189

EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT (DBM) THRU SECRETARY WENDEL AVISADO TO ALLOCATE THE AMOUNT OF NINETY EIGHTY MILLION PESOS (PHP98M) TO BE USED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF FLOOD MITIGATION STRUCTURE AND DRAINAGE SYSTEMS AND CONSTRUCTION OF CAVILLAN RIVER FLOOD PROTECTION GRAVITY WALL, ALL ARE SITUATED IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

“WHEREAS, floods have large social and economic consequences for communities and individuals where most are well aware of. The immediate impact of flooding includes the loss of human life, damage to property, destruction of crops, loss of livestock and deterioration of health conditions owing to waterborne diseases;

“WHEREAS, in agriculture, flood continue to induce damages in plants which resulted to yield losses. Flooding not only weakens plant defenses, but the soil and water conditions prevalent during flooding favor the development of many plant pathogens, so crops suffer increased disease problems after floods;

“WHEREAS, for so many years, the Municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro suffer flooding brought by heavy rains during typhoon which resulted to large volume of agricultural damage and losses taking into consideration that Bulalacao is a vast agricultural land engaged into planting of rice, corn, garlic, onions and different varieties of vegetables;

"WHEREAS, since flooding is brought by the onslaught of bad weather condition which nobody can predict where the best mitigating approach is the construction of flood control structure and drainage system on large rivers and canals in Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro; **Now, therefore, be it**

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: Earnestly request the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) thru Secretary Wendel Avisado to allocate the amount of ninety eighty million pesos (Php98M) to be used for the construction and maintenance of flood mitigation structure and drainage systems and construction of Cavillan River Flood Protection Gravity Wall, all are situated in the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro;


